HOMING PIGEON **RACES**

SEASON 1937.

The arrangements for conveyance of Homing Pigeons to take part in races are shown herein. The dates given are those on which the birds will be tendered at the originating stations.

Homing Pigeons may be charged at the Exceptional (Owner's Risk) Rates. Sender's signature should be obtained to the Consignment Note for Live Stock (Form 3534), or preferably the form of general Request for Live Stock should be signed.

Pigeons should not be so overcrowded as to cause injury or unnecessary suffering, and no receptacle containing pigeons should be accepted for transit unless the birds have sufficient free-

dom to move about.

Pigeons for Jersey and Guernsey must be booked through, but those for the French races must be booked to English Port only. Care to be taken that Customs Declaration Forms, properly filled up and signed, are sent along with the birds, except in cases where senders make a special declaration to the Customs Authorities direct.

Convoyers travelling in vans along with Pigeons will require a permit (Form P F 259) for each journey. These are to be issued at the starting stations after signature has been obtained indemnity form (P F 258), which must be witnessed by a member of the Company's staff. former document to be given up on arrival at destination station. For conditions under which Convoyers accompanying Homing Pigeons are conveyed free or at

reduced fares, see C.T. Regulation No. 88.

Every assistance must be given to the Convoyers, both as regards the forwarding and the

liberation of the birds, also en route where necessary.

In the event of Baskets of Pigeons en route to Race points having to be detained at forwarding or transfer stations awaiting despatch, the baskets must be placed where they will be under observation of the staff.

Baskets must be loaded in the vans in such a way as will admit of the birds obtaining sufficient

air, and other articles must not be placed upon them.

The greatest care must be exercised in handling the baskets throughout the journey, and they

must not under any circumstances be tilted.

When troughs are fixed to Pigeon baskets, Guards, Parcel Porters, and others must supply the birds with water, on the journey and at receiving stations, when not in charge of Convoyers.

Guards must not allow Dogs or Cats to be loaded in the vans in which Pigeons are conveyed.

All vans must be prominently labelled at the starting points with the special labels provided, which must also plainly indicate sending station, full route, and the name of Federation.

Corridor vans must be provided in order that the Convoyers may have access to the birds during transit.

Bogie vans must be supplied in all cases except where marked (S) for "Small."

Station Masters must be prepared to attach additional vans if necessary. Control must be advised immediately when this is done.

Station Masters must arrange for the loading of the traffic to be watched, and where it is thought that the number of vans supplied is excessive, the District Passenger Manager, Manchester, should be advised at once, as unnecessary haulage of vehicles may unfavourably affect the transit.

To prevent delay, the Station Masters at the Race points should, after liberation of the birds,

arrange for the empty baskets to be loaded methodically into the vans, and returned to the starting points, each van being labelled to indicate the number of baskets for the various destination stations. Latter to unload the baskets on arrival and arrange immediate despatch to the home stations.
