No. 3.—It is important that Guards working the Special trains from Twickenham should see that they are properly lighted before arrival at Twickenham New Platform.

Guards working Up trains from Twickenham New Platform must be prepared to receive the signal to start the trains from the special stage erected on platform east of overbridge, where a man will be provided for the duty.
