# DETENTION OF TRAINS FOR CONNECTIONS AT NOTTINGHAM MIDLAND.

No train may be delayed at Nottingham for the purpose of making connection, with the exception of the following which may be held for the length of time shown beyond the Working Book departure time, if by doing so the advertised connections named below can be maintained.

A train which is already running late may be held only for the additional time shown after its <u>booked departure</u> and not for that time after it is actually ready to leave.

The margins are intended to apply when the only work to be done is the usual transfer of passengers from one train to another. In cases where the transfer of loaded through vehicles has been pre-arranged authority must be sought from the District Operating Superintendent before exceeding the margin.

In the case of trains marked 'x', if the marginal allowance shown will not enable the connection to be made, the District Operating Superintendent must be consulted and will decide whether the train should be held for a longer period or despatched at its booked time and other arrangements be made.

A thin line between the hour and minute figures indicates p.m.
