IMPORTANT NOTICE—SPEED OF TRAINS

INSIDE SUBURBAN AREA:—

STEAM AND ELECTRIC TRAINS must not exceed a MAXIMUM speed of 60 miles per hour at any point, and all restrictions which impose a lower speed than 60 miles per hour must be strictly observed.

The Suburban Area for the purposes of this instruction is ALL ROUTES BETWEEN:—

London and Dartford
London and Hither Green
London and St. Mary Cray Jct. via Bickley
London and South Croydon Jct.
London and Leatherhead Ict.

Waterloo and Malden Waterloo and Feltham Jct.

OUTSIDE SUBURBAN AREA:—

- STEAM TRAINS—Must not exceed a MAXIMUM speed of 85 miles per hour at any point, and all restrictions which impose a lower speed than 85 miles per hour must be strictly observed.
- ELECTRIC TRAINS—Must not exceed a MAXIMUM speed of 75 miles per hour at any point, and all restrictions which impose a lower speed than 75 miles per hour must be strictly observed.
- MAKING UP TIME (STEAM AND ELECTRIC TRAINS)—When Passenger Trains are running late, Drivers and Motormen must endeavour to make up time, both inside and outside the Suburban Area, but all speed restrictions must be complied with.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

STARTING TIMES FROM INTERMEDIATE STATIONS.—The advertised starting time from intermediate stations is, as a rule, slightly earlier than the booked service time, and must be used in all quotations to the public. The trains must also be started at the advertised time whenever practicable.

SINGLE LINES.

The system of working on each section of Single Line is indicated on the pages showing distances by means of the following symbols:—

S Electric Staff Block Post.

One engine in steam or two or more engines coupled together.

(T) Electric Tablet Block Post (returnable).

Intermediate Key Token Post. (Non-block post where trains not conveying passengers can be shunted for other trains to pass.)

(K) Electric Key Token Block Post.

(Can be closed and long section working operate between block post on each side.)

ST Train Staff and Ticket Block Post, staff and crossing station.

Indicates crosses or passes another train on the single line.
