IMPORTANT NOTICE—SPEED OF TRAINS

STEAM TRAINS must not exceed a **MAXIMUM** speed of 85 miles per hour at any point, or 75 miles per hour in the case of former **Western Region** lines, and all restrictions which impose lower speeds than either of these must be strictly observed.

MAKING UP TIME, STEAM TRAINS.—When Passenger Trains are running late, Drivers must endeavour to make up time, but all speed restrictions must be complied with.
