Working Time Tables OF FREIGHT TRAINS

Every person supplied with a copy of these Tables is held responsible that he reads carefully and obeys all the Special Notices and instructions contained therein so far as they concern him.

On Bank Holidays and special events, some of the ordinary Services will be withdrawn and Special Services run, particulars of which will be shown in Special Traffic Notice.

In order to avoid the trainmen's hours of duty exceeding the stipulated hours, it is essential that everything possible shall be done by all concerned to assist in keeping the trains to their scheduled time. Attention is directed to Rule 142, Clause (a), which explains the circumstances under which Freight Trains may be allowed to run in advance of the scheduled times. A great deal can be done in this direction at stations by ascertaining the actual running of Passenger Trains, and calculating the time required by Freight Trains to do their work and clear the station in advance, and the co-operation of the staff generally is invited to this end.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

SPEED OF TRAINS

A maximum speed of 60 miles an hour must not be exceeded by trains at any point and all restrictions which impose a lower speed than 60 miles an hour must be strictly observed.
