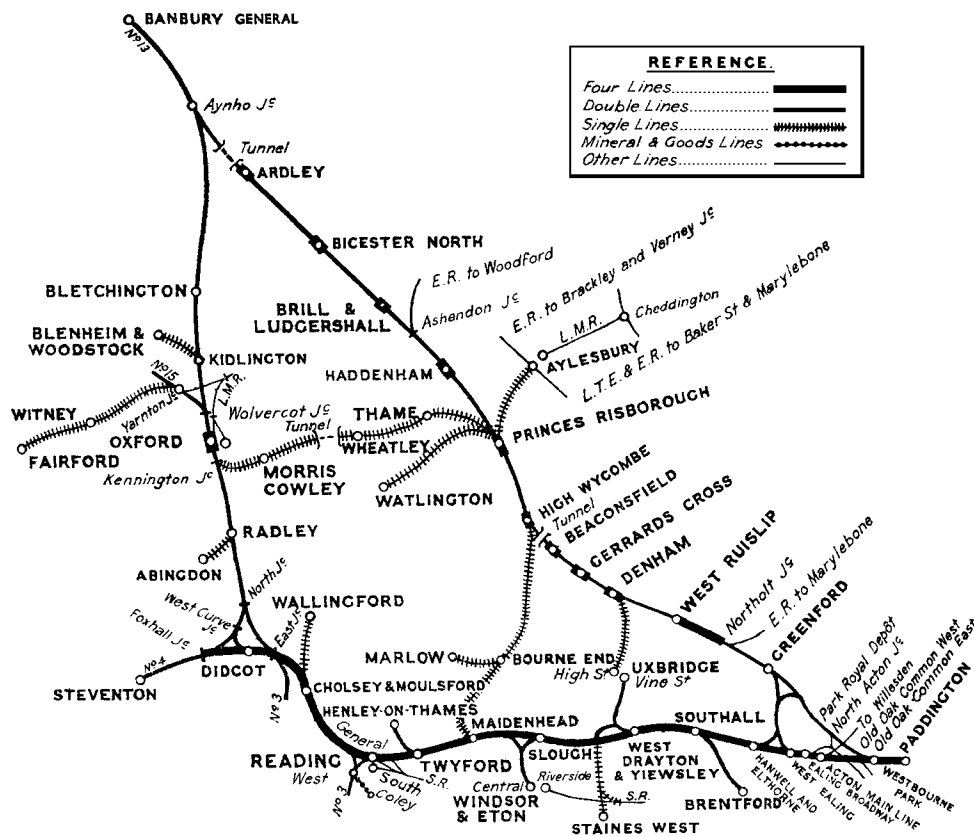

**IMPORTANT NOTICE**

The time specified in the Time Tables is the departure from the station when the times of arrival and departure are not stated, and in such cases the trains should ARRIVE in sufficient time to enable the work to be done, in order to leave the Station at the time appointed.

The advertised departure times of Passenger Trains in a number of instances are slightly earlier than the Service Book times, and the former must be used in all quotations to the public. The trains must also leave at the ADVERTISED time whenever practicable.

### APPENDIX TO SERVICE BOOK.

Each Railway employee supplied with a Copy of this book must have in his possession a Current Copy of No. 1 Service Book Appendix and is responsible for obtaining same from his superior Officer.

#### TRAINS STARTING FROM PADDINGTON PASSENGER STATION. ENGINES NOT TO EMIT SMOKE UNDER STATION ROOF.

When a train stands in a position which necessitates the train engine going under the station roof, the engine on arrival at the departure platform must stand at the platform starting signal outside the roof, and not back on to the coaches until five minutes before starting time. Whilst standing on the train the enginemen must see that the emission of smoke is reduced to a minimum.

#### IMPORTANT NOTICE.

Every care must be taken to avoid running over PACKS OF HOUNDS, which during the Hunting Season may cross the Line. All Railway employees are hereby enjoined to use every care consistent with a due regard being paid to the proper working of the Line and Trains.
