MAINTENANCE OF CONNECTIONS INSTRUCTIONS— BRISTOL (T.M.)

No Up Train train is to be held for a train from Avonmouth Dock or Portishead unless there is an advertised margin of 9 or more minutes, and no Down Train is to be held for a train from Avonmouth Dock or Portishead unless there is an advertised margin of 11 or more minutes: but if there is the specified advertised margin, the train must be held if the Avonmouth Dock or Portishead train is signalled. A Down train calling at Parson Street must not be held for and Up Portishead train. No train to Avonmouth Dock or Portishead, except where specially shewn otherwise, must be held for any other train, but must be started as soon as ready.

Except where shewn otherwise, a Western Region train may be held for another Western Region train if the latter is signalled, provided there is an advertised margin of **7 minutes** between the arrival of one train and the departure of the other.

Whenever Up Passenger trains are running out of order shewn in Service Book, or a Special is running in or about the time of any ordinary passenger trains, a Box-to-Box message will be sent from Worle Junction to Claverham and will be passed forward from Claverham to Bristol West Box as necessary.

* In any case where these instructions would result in a late start of more than 20 minutes, further instructions should be obtained from D.O.S.O. as to the course to be adopted.
